

PROGRAMS OFFERED

HEAD START:

The Redding Rancheria offers a part-day Native American program to eligible children ages 3-5. We follow the local public school calendar. Classes are offered in an AM/PM format with classes from 8am-12pm or 12pm-4pm. Limited transportation is available by school bus. Head Start is a federally funded program. Parents do not need to be working or going to school to qualify for Head Start, but must be below the income ceiling. There is no fee for the Head Start Program.

PRIORITY:

Head Start and Child Care prioritize and enroll families based on need. Some of the priorities include: Native American, foster care, homelessness, children with disabilities, low income and pre-k aged children. All families are encouraged to apply and those with lesser priorities are enrolled if vacancies become available.



CHILD CARE:

The Redding Rancheria offers a Full Day Child Care program for children ages 3-5 whose parents are working a minimum of 25 hours a week. Parents can be going to school but must have third-party funding to pay their monthly fee (TANF/SCOE). The Child Care program follows the Head Start calendar. The Child Care Program has a sliding scale fee.

SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE:

Children ages 3-5 may enroll for the full day program. To be eligible, you must be Native American, working at least 25 hours per week and fall under the income ceiling. The sliding scale fees in our Child Care program are designed to assist low to moderate-income level working families. Limited transportation via school bus is available. Applications are accepted and scored on an ongoing basis.

PRIVATE PAY CHILD CARE:

For those families over the income ceiling a limited number of private pay child care slots are available. Call us for current fees.



QUALITY PROGRAMMING:

Both the Head Start and Child Care adhere to the highest program quality standards, with the goal that each child receives a "Head Start" to school readiness. Parents play an important role in their child's education through communication, attending special events, and working with staff to ensure each families needs are met.

MEALS AND SNACKS:

Both the Head Start and Child Care program participate in the "Child and Adult Food Program." The program is available without charge to all enrolled children. In accordance with Federal Law and U.S. Department of Agriculture policy pertaining to this program, this institution is prohibited from discriminating on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

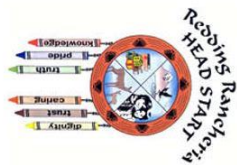
