Redding Rancheria Community Fund Awards over \$100,000 in Spring Grants

The Redding Rancheria Community Fund has awarded grants to 43 nonprofits in Shasta and Trinity counties for their Spring grant cycle. The total funds distributed is \$112,688 and will support organizations in the arts, youth services, education, public safety, and healthcare.
