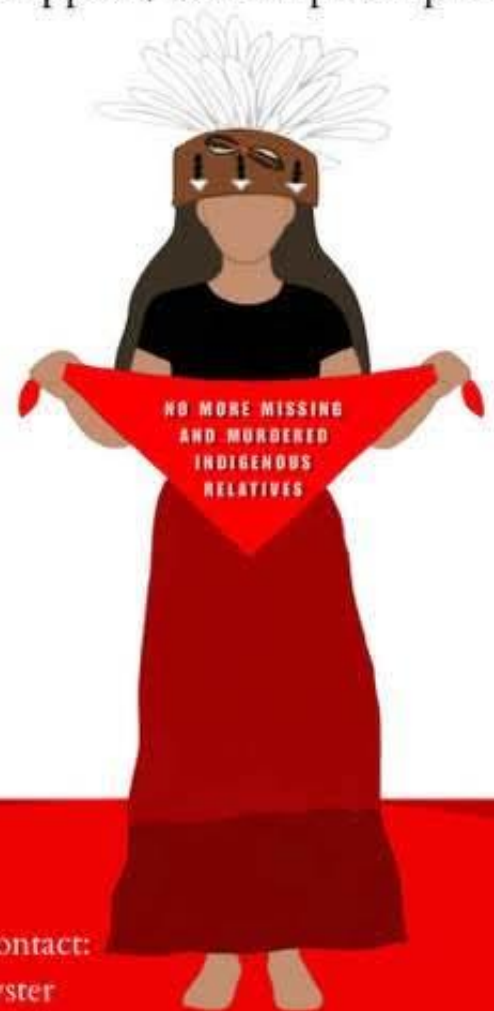
Peaceful Awareness Gathering in front of City Hall (777 Cypress Ave)
